# 2023-24 Transportation Services



## General Information

Transportation is offered from the first day of school. Bus passes must be purchased by August 31, 2023. There is a 10% early bird discount offered for full year payments received by August 18, 2023. After bus passes are distributed to students on September 1, students will be required to have their bus pass in their possession every time they board the bus.

Bus passes are not required before September 1, or for students at Latrobe Elementary going to after school Extended Day, sports, or enrichment programs at Miller's Hill School.

For students who ride the bus occasionally, we offer single-use tickets that are sold in sheets of 10 tickets for \$10 in the school office. Each ticket is for a single one-way ride. They are not available online.

## Bus Stops

Latrobe School District contracts with the El Dorado Union High School District for home-to-school transportation. Bus stops are determined by the EDUHS District Transportation Department. There is one route each for morning and afternoon transportation. Routes are posted when available at <http://www.eduhsd.k12.ca.us/transportation> and linked on the Latrobe School District. ## Payments

To purchase and pay for a bus pass you may pay online via Paypal on our website at [www.latrobeschool.com/departments/transportation](http://www.latrobeschool.com/departments/transportation). Alternatively, you may complete a paper application and pay with a check made out to Latrobe School District. We are not able to accept credit cards.

There is an option to pay for bus services in two payments. The first payment is due by August 31, 2023 and the second one will be due January 15, 2024. There is no early bird discount for semi-annual payments. A reminder notice will be sent prior to Winter Break for the second payment.

## Reduced Rate

Parents or guardians who meet certain income eligibility guidelines may qualify for free or reduced bus rates. Applications for Free and Reduced Bus Fees must be printed out and submitted in person (no online application available). **Verification of income is required with the Free and Reduced Transportation Application.** Please see current income eligibility guidelines on the reverse.

## Student Behavior and Discipline

All existing policies and rules regarding safety, student behavior, and discipline on school grounds also apply on school buses. Cameras are mounted on the bus to monitor daily activity. Bus rules are printed in the Parent/Student Handbook, and at [www.latrobeschool.com/departments/transportation](http://www.latrobeschool.com/departments/transportation).

## Refund Policy

Requests for refunds must be submitted in writing and will be made for the following reasons only:

1. After a student leaves the district, refunds will be prorated; subtracting out the days the student was enrolled in the district and able to utilize services.
2. After paying bus fees a student has been determined to be eligible for free or reduced fees.

Two Semi-Annual Payments (no discount)	August 31, 2023 and January 15, 2024
